

Did You Know...

"When traveling with your pet, it is always advisable to keep a health certificate (a document from your veterinarian certifying that your pet is in good health) and medical records close at hand. If you and your pet will be traveling across state lines, you must obtain from your veterinarian a recent health certificate and a certificate of rabies vaccination. Although pets may travel freely throughout the United States as long as they have proper documentation, Hawaii requires a 30- or 120-day quarantine for all dogs and cats. Hawaii's quarantine regulations vary by species, so check prior to travel [...]"

Can Be Used For:

- When you bring your pet to Daycare/boarding,
- Every time you need to show proof of immunizations
- When dealing with pet sitting companies
- When you need to show proof of Ownership (if pet gets lost) – microchip/tattoo info + photo & owner ID.
- To facilitate record keeping and/or changing veterinary offices. the customer can immediately show all records while minimizing paperwork and transfer of information time.
- If disaster strikes, shelters and locations accepting pets do require health record documentation.

How It Works:

1. Get 1 Wag'N Pet Passport™ PER PET.
2. Fill out your Information on Page 1.
3. Fill out the pet info on Page 2 and add a picture of your pet.
4. Fill out Microchip/Tattoo Info on Page 3.
5. Bring your Wag'N Pet Passport™ to your primary veterinarian's office and ask them to please fill out, stamp and sign each section appropriate to the pet.
6. Bring your Wag'N Pet Passport™ with you every time you go for a veterinary visit. Whatever the pet gets done, ask your vet to add the update, and don't forget to have the immunization stamped and signed by the vet. Without the official vet signature and stamp the information cannot be considered valid.
7. Keep your Wag'N Pet Passport™ with you when traveling by air. When traveling by car leave it in the glove compartment box so that you always have the records with you no matter where you go!

We recommend you make a copy of the pages to ensure that you have a backup copy for your own record.
